

# What to bring to camp

- Bedding – sleeping bag OR blanket / sheets, pillow (we have some bedding; you MUST bring a pillow)
- Sunblock
- Cap or hat (optional)
- Bug spray (each counselor will have some to use for the kids as well.)
- Toiletries – soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste
- Towels, washcloths
- Complete age appropriate Bible (Old Testament and New Testament) (with the campers name in it)
- Small notebook to take notes (with a pen)
- Dirty clothes bag – write campers name on it (This can be a big black trash bag.)
- Tennis shoes – for wear during the day (don't forget the socks!)
- Swimsuit (Modest, one piece for girls. No bellies showing!)
- Flip flops (to wear to the pool)
- Pajamas (Or something to sleep in)
- Casual, comfortable, play clothes (Modest!)
- Flashlight
- A non-breakable water bottle (Put your name on it! We recommend a stainless steel water bottle that will keep your water cold for hours. NOT plastic)
- sunglasses (optional)
- Spending money. We will have a camp store/ concession stand. (A \$5 camp store card is included with their camp registration) The \$5 camp store card is plenty for most campers. Campers are advised to NOT have cash. .. so if they want more spending more, convert it to camp cash upon arrival.

This is an unplugged camp. Do NOT bring an Ipod, cell phone, CD player, pocket knife, comic books or magazines, or fireworks. If you bring your phone (and you really shouldn't!), please check it in with Mrs. Fondee upon arrival. You will have Mrs. Fondee and Pastor Joe's cell number in case of emergencies, to check in with your camper if needed.

Upon arrival at camp, your child will be given a camp packet. This includes a t-shirt, \$5 camp card for the store (this will be kept on file in the camp store.), and a camp booklet with schedule, devotions, etc.

Please label all your child's belongings with his / her first and last name and counsel them to be responsible for their things during camp. We will not be held responsible for lost items. Lost items will be placed in lost and found and we will bring the items to church. You will have one week to pick up your items; they will then be donated or dumped. Do not send anything extremely valuable (other than your child!)
